

Roller Cup 2023

The aim of the Roller Cup is to create a competitive events structure for non-championship and beginner athletes that will run throughout the year.

It will give non-championship athletes a greater motivation in training and allow coaches and athletes to set goals and objectives for the skating year. It will give beginner athletes and parents an insight into the competitive events.

For 2023 the Roller Cup will be made up of 3 events and a final.

Scoring System

The top 10 skaters in each event will receive points, the points structure will be as follows:

Competition Rules

For 2023 we are introducing the move to RollArt for all events apart from Non-Medallist, we will use the Basic Roller requirements that consists of 1 Compulsory Dance and 1 Free Dance

Applications

Clubs should enter all athletes who intend to compete in the Roller Cup competitions in 2023, the application form can be found on the GBSA Website (http://fars.co.uk/forms-information/) The closing date for entering the Roller Cup is 6th February 2023.

Entering Rules

- 1. It is mandatory that all athletes commit to entering two (2) Roller Cup competitions
- 2. Athletes can choose to enter 2 or 3 of the events, only the two best scores will be used to make up the top 5 who will reach the final. (Athletes will not be allocated events)
- 3. Payment will be made to the hosting club when requested, the cost to enter the Roller Cup is £30 per event.





- 4. Athletes can enter the event associated with their current test level or above. The Dance Club test or Advanced test is accepted.
- 5. Athletes will be kept at the same standard for all Roller Cup events even if additional tests are taken in 2023.
- 6. Events will be split by age were applicable to respect the limits of events, once the splits have been made, they will be the same splits for every competition.
- 7. If you decide to leave the Roller Cup structure during the year, the athlete and their results will be removed.

Competition Rules

- 1. All events apart from Non-Medallist will be judged using a closed RollArt System. Non-Medallist will be judged under the white system.
- 2. No live points will be shown or announced. PDF's will be available at the end of the event.
- 3. In solo dance events Ladies Solo Dance steps will be skated only.
- 4. For half sequence dances 4 (four) sequences will be skated. For full sequences dances 2 (two) sequences will be skated.
- 5. The final will be made up of the top 5 skaters from each event.
- 6. The final will be a one off final event, no points from the previous events will be carried over.
- 7. The final for Non-Medallist will be judged under RollArt, if the Dance Team agree that the standard is of the correct level for RollArt.
- 8. Results and league tables will be communicated on GBSA website and GBSA socials post events.
- 9. The top 3 of each section (dance and free dance) will receive awards as well as the combined winner.
- 10. If any athletes compete in any category in the 2023 championships including Classics and Masters, they will be removed from the Roller Cup.
- 11. In the event of a draw the components score will be used to split the athletes. **Excluding Non-Medallist.**
- 12. The dances for the final will be drawn at round 3.
- 13. There must be a minimum of 5 athletes entered into the category for it to go ahead. This will be communicated after the closing date.
- 14. Element sheets will be needed for each event. One email per club should be sent when requested from GBSA. Only WorldSkate PDF elements sheets will be accepted. Handwritten documents or photos/scans will not be accepted. <u>https://www.worldskate.org/artistic/about/regulations/category/900-content-sheet-</u>202%202.html
