

TEST PROCEDURES

F.A.R.S. Tests are only available to Members of the Federation

Applications for a Test must be received at FARS Office 28 days prior to taking a test

Application Forms are available from FARS Office or are downloadable from FARS Web Site

Clubs or Trainers must have a minimum of at least five tests to be taken at one time,

This is to help cut the costs, as the floor charge and the Judges travel costs are paid by the Candidates.

Two venues, two dates plus times must be on the individual application forms

Trainers or Club Secretaries will then contact the Local Test Organiser for Judges availability.

Test Organisers will do their best to try for the times – dates – venues that are requested.

Local Test Organiser will refer back to the Applicants when details are finalised

After tests are completed the Test papers will be sent back to the F.A.R.S. office

A Certificate will be issued if the test has been passed.

Should the Test fail and the Candidate wish to re-take the Test, a new Application with the appropriate fee should be sent to FARS Office 28 days prior to taking a test

Silver tests and above can only be taken at an official test day

Please remember that Judges always hope to pass a test and will allow part of the test to be reskated should they consider there is a chance of improvement and therefore passing.
